\*Product Selection Cost - If you obtain a brand-name drug when a generic equivalent is available, you are responsible for the generic copayment plus the cost difference between the brand-name drug and the generic drug.

\*\*The University of New Mexico has partnered with SaveonSP to provide a specialty pharmacy copay assistance program for a select group of specialty medications. Upon qualification and enrollment, medications will be reimbursed by the manufacturer and result in no cost to the member. Please reference your University of New Mexico prescription plan handbook for more information. Note: excluded from out-of-pocket expenses.

### Saving with Home Delivery

When you get maintenance medications (those prescription drugs you take regularly) at a retail pharmacy, you could be paying more than you need to. ### Saving with Generics

If your doctor agrees, ask your doctor to write a new prescription for the generic that you can fill through your prescription benefit.
